


## Directions to Transfer Station

From downtown Dawsonville, take Shoal Creek Road for .5 miles.

Turn right onto Burt Creek Road.

The Transfer Station will be 0.75 miles ahead on the right.

### **Recycling is Free**

Household bagged trash is \$0.50 a bag.

## Items Accepted

in the

### Dawson County Recycling Program

All recyclable materials can be placed together in the recycling container.

This is called **Single-Stream recycling**.

- **Aluminum:** aluminum foil, pie tins, tin cans, steel cans
- **Batteries:** household alkaline: AAA, AA, C, D, 9-volt
- **Cardboard:** Flattened cardboard paper board, toilet paper and paper towel rolls. Please remove plastic liners from cereal & snack boxes.
- **Glass Bottles / Jars:** All colors.
- **Paper:** brown paper bags, junk mail, magazines, newspaper, office paper, phone books, etc... Please do not tie or bundle.
- **Motor Oil**
- **Plastic: #1 -#7:** To best identify plastic types look at the bottom of the containers.  
#1 PET: Soda bottles, waters bottles, etc...  
#2 HDPE: Milk jugs, detergent bottles, spray bottles, etc...  
#3 PVC: Loose-leaf binders and plastic pipes, etc...  
#4 LDPE: Dry cleaning bags, produce bags, squeezable bottles, etc...  
#5 PP: Medicine bottles, drinking straws, ketchup bottles, sour cream/butter tubs.  
#6 PS: Compact disc jackets and plastic tableware, etc...  
#7 Other: Reusable water bottles, certain kinds of food containers and Tupperware.

## Items NOT Accepted

in the

### Dawson County Recycling Program

- **Coated Cardboard:** wax or plastic coated paper/boxes of any kind.
- **Electronic Devices:** cellphones, computer monitors & parts, etc.
- **Food-soiled Items:** aluminium foil, tin cans, pizza boxes, food containers, paper plates, etc...
- **Glass:** drinking glasses, light bulbs, mirrors, window glass, ceramics, China; Pyrex dishes, etc...
- **Hard Cover Books**
- **Lithium Batteries**
- **Packaging Materials:** polystyrene (Styrofoam), packaging peanuts, or heavy duty plastic
- **Paint Cans**
- **Paper Towels, Tissue or Toilet Paper**
- **Photographs**
- **Plastic:** Any type of recycling that has NO number for recycling.
- **Spray or Aerosol Cans** of any kind.
- **Styrofoam**

**Recycling** reduces the amount of waste going into our landfills, helping to prolong its useful life.
