

**MINUTES
CITY COUNCIL WORK SESSION
SEPTEMBER 19, 2016
5:00 P.M.**

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor W. James Grogan called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL: Present were: Mayor James Grogan, Councilmember Angie Smith, Councilmember Caleb Phillips, Councilmember Jason Power, Councilmember Mike Sosebee, City Attorney Dana Miles, City Clerk Bonnie Warne, Utilities Director Gary Barr, Operations Manager Trampas Hansard and Permits Nalita Copeland.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE: Invocation and pledge was led by: Jason Power.

AGENDA: Motion to approve the agenda as presented by: A. Smith/J. Power. Vote carried unanimously in favor.


Filters for Well 108 & 109: Gary Barr, Public Works Director, spoke on upgrading the filters on wells 108 and 109 which will allow them to run 24 hours a day and monitor with phones using SCADA. Turnipseed Engineers would draw it up with the specs and would get sealed bids on it. Estimated cost on backwash system and filters is about \$130,000. Council authorized Gary to move forward and acquire bids.

Mobile Vendors / Food Trucks: Attorney Miles provided Council with a draft ordinance amendment for discussion. Changes made and Attorney Miles asked if other changes need to be made to email him and Council. Ordinance to go on Oct. 3rd meeting.

2017 Rates for Insurance Benefits from Georgia Municipal Employees Benefit System (GMEBS) for City Staff and Elected Officials: Council discussed the rate increase for medical and dental coverage for 2017. Rate increase of \$8 for employees and officials and \$11 for dependents. Item to be added to Oct 3rd meeting for a vote on the percentage to be paid by the City.

ADJOURNMENT: With there being no further business to attend to the meeting closed and adjourned at 5:51 p.m. The motion carried unanimously; J. Power/M. Sosebee.






