Adult Literacy Center GED Test Info and New Hours

The Adult Learning Center of Lanier Technical College offers free GED preparation classes to anyone 16 and older.

The center is preparing for a busy September. The last day of summer quarter is September 12, then fall quarter begins September 29. You are welcome to come in any time during the quarter and take the pre-test. If you would like to take it between quarters, just call the Adult Learning Center for an appointment.

Starting September 29, the Adult Learning Center will no longer be open on Fridays, but Monday through Thursday hours of 8-8 will remain the same.

Our biggest news is that the Adult Learning Center has been approved as an official GED testing site. The GED is a 2 day test. The first set of tests will be given September 16 and 30 at the Adult Learning Center.

You must enroll and register at least 2 weeks prior to test day. Seats are reserved on a first come-first served basis, so don't wait until the last day.

The fee to take all 5 parts of the GED tests is \$95 or \$19 for each individual test. For additional information on the program or the GED test, call the Adult Learning Center at 706/265-1690.



Notice of Mandatory Water Restrictions Effective June 19, 2008—December 31, 2008

Level IV b Drought Response Modifications

The City of Dawsonville applied for and received some relief from state mandated watering restrictions.

The following is in effect until December 31, 2008 unless further notice is received from the state DNR.

All outdoor water uses are allowed on an odd/even basis, two days per week between midnight and 10:00 a.m.

**Odd addresses may water on
Thursdays and Sundays.**

**Even addresses may water on
Wednesdays and Saturdays.**

The following uses are still prohibited:

Using hydrants for any purpose other than firefighting, public health, safety or flushing; and

Washing Hard surfaces, such as streets, gutters, sidewalks and driveways except when necessary for public
