Notice of General Election—Tuesday, November 3, 2009

The City of Dawsonville will hold a General Election On Tuesday, November 3, 2009, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Purpose of Election:

The purpose of the election is due to the expiration of the term of office for two members of the City Council.

Voters Registration:

City residents who wish to participate by voting in the November 3, 2009 election will have until October 5, 2009 to register to vote. Registration can occur at City Hall or at the Dawson County Board of Elections.

Candidate Qualifications:

No person shall be qualified or eligible to seek election unless he/she meets the following requirements:

- 1) Must be a resident of the City of Dawsonville for a period of at least one year immediately prior to the date he or she takes office;
- 2) continues to reside within the City during his or her period of service;
- 3) is registered and qualified to vote in municipal elections of the City of Dawsonville; and

- 4) meets any applicable requirements imposed under Article 14, Chapter 2 of the Georgia Election Code.

Qualifying Period:

Candidates may qualify August 31 through September 4, 2009 from 8:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. in the City Clerk's office located at City Hall, 415 Hwy. 53 East, Suite 100.

Qualifying Process:

During the qualifying period, prospective candidates must file with the City Clerk:

- 1) A notarized notice of candidacy and affidavit; and
- 2) a qualifying fee of \$180.00 for the office councilmember.

Prospective candidates may obtain an election package from the City Clerk's office. Candidates desiring to accept campaign contributions must file form DOI (Declaration of Intention to Accept Campaign Contributions) prior to receiving any contributions. Anyone presenting himself/herself as a candidate in the election and/or accepting in-kind or monetary donations must file a Campaign Contribution Disclosure Report



Non-Drought Water Use Schedule

The EPD Director has placed the entire state of Georgia under a non-drought schedule for outdoor water use.

Under a non-drought schedule outdoor water use is allowed three days a week on assigned days using odd and even-numbered addresses.

Odd numbered addresses may water on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays.

Even numbered addresses may water on Mondays, Wednesdays and Saturdays.

Water use may occur at any time of the day on the assigned days, but to be water efficient, landscape watering should not occur between 10 a.m.—4 p.m.

The non-drought schedule is included in the Rules for Outdoor Water Use. These rules can be found at the following web sites or a copy is available at City Hall: www.gaepd.org or www.dawsonville-ga.gov
