To vote in advance for the ELOST election please go to the County Registrars office at 462 Memory Lane, from 8:00 a.m.—5:00 p.m.

There is NO VOTING on Monday, November 2nd.

The last day to vote is on Election Day, Tuesday, November 3, 2009 from 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m. The Municipal Election and the countywide ELOST Election (Dawsonville & Etowah Precincts) will be held in the American Legion Bingo Hall at the Dawsonville Municipal Complex.
