

Dawsonville Courtyard Apartments Reopen

An apartment complex has recently reopened for business in Dawsonville. First constructed in 2005, the 16 units known as "Dawsonville Courtyard" were only lived in for a short time before being lost to foreclosure by the original owners. In foreclosure, these apartments on Courtyard Drive off Hwy 9 South sat vacant almost 3 years before new owners purchased the property and performed renovations restoring the complex to "like new" condition. Each unit consists of roughly 1,000 square feet with 2 bedrooms and either 1.5 or 2 bathrooms. Monthly rent starts at just \$625 including water, sewer, garbage, and basic cable. In order to refill the complex with residents quickly, the new owners are also offering a free month of rent to qualified tenants. Valentine Parfait Cupcakes

Ingredients:

- 1 box Betty Crocker® SuperMoist® devil's food cake mix
- Water, vegetable oil and eggs called for on cake mix box
- 1 can (1 lb) Betty Crocker® Whipped fluffy white frosting
- 1 cup semisweet or milk chocolate chips (6 oz)
- 2 teaspoons shortening
- Betty Crocker® Decorating Decors hearts

Directions:

1. Heat oven to 350°F (325°F for dark or nonstick pans). Place paper baking cup in each of 24 regular-size muffin cups. Make cake batter as directed on cake mix box, using water, oil and eggs. Divide batter evenly among muffin cups (about 2/3 full).
2. Bake 20 to 25 minutes or until toothpick inserted in center come out clean. Cool in pans 10 minutes; remove from pans to cooling racks. Cool completely, about 30 minutes.
3. Spoon frosting into decorating bag fitted with large round tip. Pipe dollop of frosting on top of each cupcake.
4. In small microwavable bowl, microwave chocolate chips and shortening uncovered on High 1 minute, stirring once halfway through heating. Drizzle melted chocolate over frosted cupcakes; sprinkle with hearts.
