NOTICE OF WATER AND WASTEWATER RATE INCREASE

This notice is to inform you of the City of Dawsonville's rate increase for water and wastewater fees that will appear on your **September 2024** utility bill.

In order to be able to continue providing quality utility services, the City Council adopted the first phase of an increased rate structure at their August 5, 2024 regular meeting to accommodate increased operating costs, improvements to both water and wastewater systems and for the construction of a new water pollution control plant.
